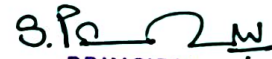

These outcomes highlight the potential benefits of celebrating Pongal in a UG college, from cultural awareness and social bonding to educational and entertainment value.

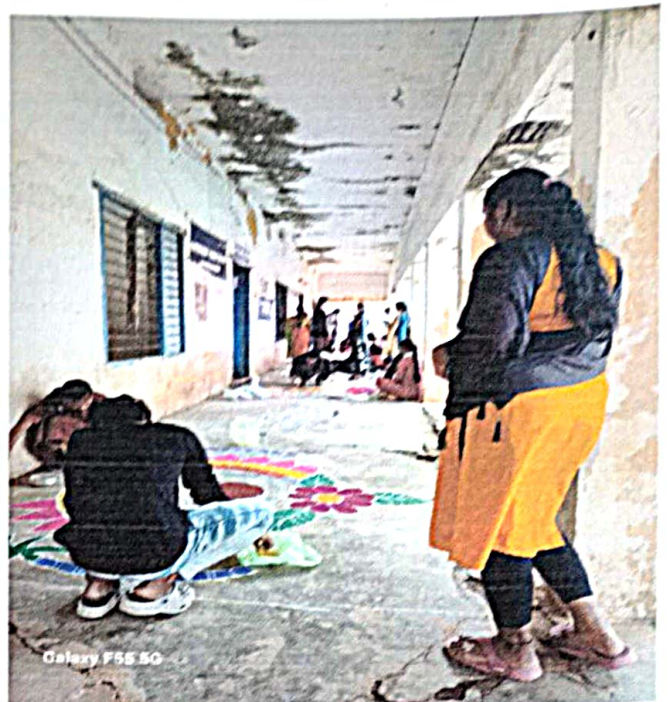

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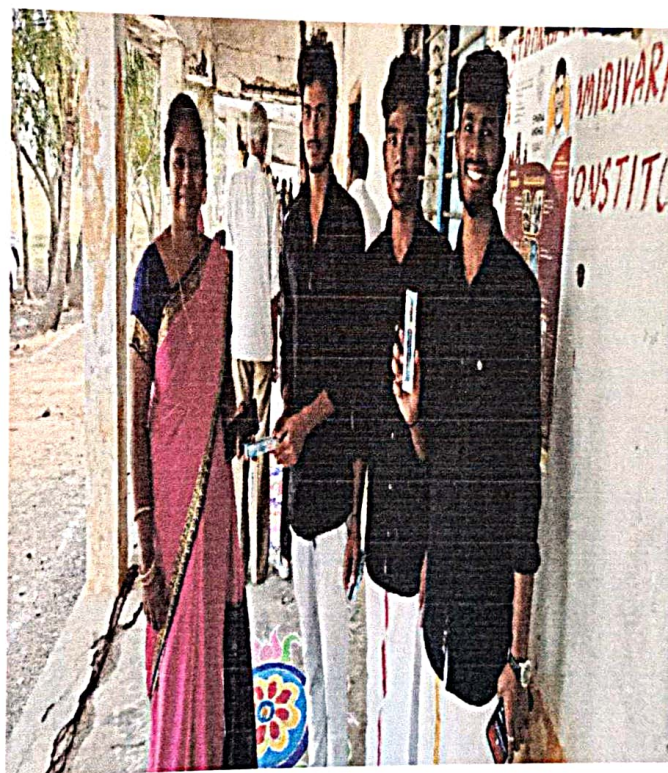


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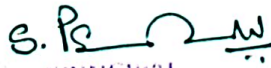
PRIZES DISTRIBUTION FOR TREDITIONAL DRESS AND RANGOLI
